



Do You or a Loved One Have a Disability?

The rights to treatment at hospitals, doctors' offices and more are in danger!

- *Texas vs. Beccera* is an active lawsuit seeking to get rid of Section 504, part of a 1973 civil rights law that prohibits discrimination on the basis of disability.
- Section 504 protects disabled people's right to enter, and receive services and accommodations (ex: ramps, ASL interpreters, braille, captions, screen readers) anywhere that receives federal funding or grants. This includes public schools, doctors and hospitals that take Medicaid/Medicare and many more basic services.
- 17 States are currently signed on to the lawsuit, but if 504 is struck down, it will have a national effect. The suit's status is due to be updated 25 February 2025.

The good news? *There's still time to fight!*
